

KAITURI REEDS – QUALITY REEDS MADE IN FINLAND

Please note, that during manufacture the reed dents are protected with oil. Before you use your reed for the first time please clean it with a soft cloth or brush. The reed dents are made of quality spring steel, but a hard hit with e.g. a shuttle may bend them permanently, so be careful.

Make sure that the reed fits in the groove of your beater. The reed should be stored in a dry place in either a vertical or horizontal position to prevent corrosion and bending.

In humid environments we recommend our stainless steel Arctic Reed which will not rust.

For production weaving or using a flying shuttle we recommend our new full metal Profile Reed available made in either carbon or stainless steel.

The reeds are packed in plastic covers and thus protected against dust and humidity during storage and transport.



TOIKA has manufactured reeds as a company since 1898. Already before that Johannes Pihlgren, the father of Gustaf Pihlgren, who is the founder of Toika, travelled around Northern Finland supplying households with reeds.
